Aboriginal Languages Sustainable Funding Program Eligible Applicants 2023-2024**

The Aboriginal Languages Sustainable Funding Program provides grants between \$25,000 up to \$60,000 to Aboriginal Community organisations and groups successfully funded under previous Aboriginal Languages Community Investment Programs from 2021-2022 and 2022-2023, to support the continuation and growth of successful Languages projects.

This is a closed round grant program, with 17 eligible applicants invited to apply.

The total amount of funding allocated to this program in 2023-24 is \$990,000.
